How many emergency communications networks are there in Victoria?

Today, there are four state contracts which provide emergency services communications networks covering: These shared networks are in addition to various agency-specific networks. Where can I listen to emergency information?

These sources include local radio, television, and state and territory emergency service websites or apps. For example, during emergency situations people can listen to ABC Local Radio to receive up-to-date warnings. You should also consider downloading the Emergency+ app.

Does Australia have a radiocommunications system?

All Australian states and territories have established dedicated radiocommunications systems for use by emergency services. The Australian Government provides support to the states and territories through the Radiocommunications Act 1992, including making sure adequate spectrum is available for agencies providing emergency services.

How do emergency alert devices work in Australia?

These devices are readily available from a number of recognised providers and can operate across the entire Australian landmass. Emergency Alert is the national telephone warning system used by emergency services to send voice messages to landlines and text messages to mobile phones within a defined area regarding likely or actual emergencies.

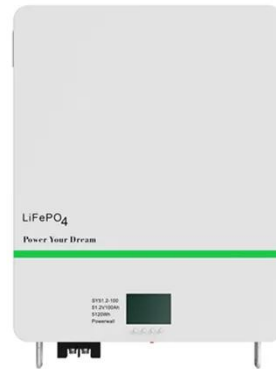

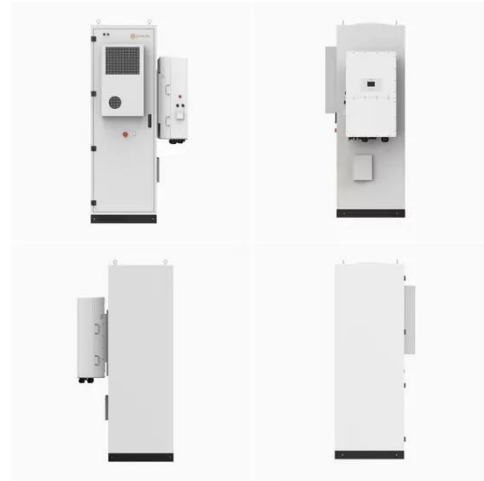
