Can I bring an outdoor power supply into Nigeria



Overview

Do I need a travel adapter in Nigeria?

If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Nigeria, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter. All power sockets in Nigeria provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz.

Do I need an adapter to use a charger in Nigeria?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Nigeria outlet. Nigeria uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types D & G (see images).

Can I use electronic devices in Nigeria without an adapter?

Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. Nigeria uses outlet types D, G at a voltage of 230V and a frequency of 50 Hz. Plug Compatibility: Type D, Type G Voltage: 230V Frequency: 50 Hz Can North Americans use Electronics in Nigeria without an Adapter?

What type of plug does Nigeria use?

Nigeria uses two different plug types: D and G. Plug type D is a three-pin plug with two round pins and a larger, round earth pin. Plug type G is similar to type D, but with a rectangular earth pin instead of a round one. Both plug types are commonly used in Nigeria, and it is important to have an adapter that accommodates both.

Do North Americans need an adapter in Nigeria?

No! North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for

the voltage when traveling to Nigeria. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Nigeria. Also, the voltage in Nigeria is different from North American voltages. Can Europeans use Electronics in Nigeria without an adapter?
